A World-class Work Destination, With Fascinating Architecture

Transformed from a blueprint to reality, Candor TechSpace in Sector 135, Noida will soon have a new addition, Tower 11, to its expansive campus, creating a work destination that blurs the line between a workspace and a place of well-being.

Candor TechSpace, Sector 135, Noida is one of the largest office parks in the IT/ITES hub of the city that draws its inspiration from the ancient planning techniques of the iconic 'Taj Mahal' and 'India Gate'. Nearing its completion, Candor TechSpace has added 'Tower 11' to create a work destination abiding by international standards while celebrating, utilizing and contemporizing historical and architectural design knowledge. "We wanted to imbibe the quality of placemaking that historical public buildings offer therefore, the campus planning draws inspiration and learning from ancient planning techniques of the iconic Taj Mahal", shares Alok Aggarwal, Managing Director and CEO, Brookfield Properties.

Inspired by the Taj Mahal's ethos, the design of the entrance lobby is a three-storied volume, placed with white marble walls that offer monumentality and grandeur to every visitor. The well-designed and optimized, expansive floor plates with minimized space wastage create seamless, functional and efficient spaces. The facade of the new addition is a contemporary adaptation of the triumphant arch of the India Gate that embraces and recreates the opulent yet welcoming aesthetic as the rays of the sun reflect off it. The black glass reflective waterbody located in

the foreground surrounded by lush greens modernizes the ancient planning and cooling techniques while employing placemaking tools to generate a stimulating environment.

BUILDING MONUMENTALITY

The ecology focuses on pedestrian mobility; the air and the sounds create a built environment that can inspire the end-user and open the mind to a depth of experiences. The focus on linearity in shared spaces creates a sense of cohesive continuity with segregated vehicular and pedestrian circulation to define public areas. In addition, the campus is equipped with amenities, ranging from curated retail, F&B and fitness, to banking and crèche facilities, all

of which are distributed within the 30,000 sf amenities block. The design focus for the public areas is not to landscape or hardscape, but people-scape to curate experiences that stimulate and excite the end-user. "Under the shadows of the frangipani trees and transported by the fragrance of tropical flowers, we are hoping to create a new place, a new destination for each end-user to write his or her own story", shares Ricardo Bofill, Principal Chief Architect, Tower 11, Candor

TechSpace, Sector 135, Noida.



The ground floor is a mix of marble lobbies in elegant white shades and overlooks a black mirror reflective water feature, with a lush garden all around. This provides a placemaking experience rarely seen before in an office building", shares Ricardo Bofill.

Certified by the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC), the platinum-rated campus is designed to facilitate distributed green landscapes, waste management systems, energy efficiency, reduced use of fossil fuels and health and well-being of its occupants.

The campus also incorporates air purifiers, mainly

STIMULATING ENVIRONMENTS THAT OFFER MORE THAN JUST LANDSCAPES

Here, the central landscape park alone covers 34.37% of the land as green cover, creating a campus that lives and breathes. There are approximately 467 trees of over 15 varieties in the park, including flower

beds. Additionally, rerouting of traffic has been undertaken to create more green spaces in the campus. The pedestrian walkways that connect the central landscape have undergone a makeover by using stamped concrete and are extended within the landscape in biophilic patterns, creating lush, green and shaded strolling spaces rich in biodiversity. There is also an amphitheater in the central courtyard where live Olympics and cricket matches were relayed.

The landscape is designed to include various enclosures that foster collaboration and well-being. For instance, the outdoor work pods and semicovered seating areas here boost creative thinking and productivity.

A 'SUSTAINABILITY FIRST' APPROACH

Certified by the Indian Green Building Council (IGBC), the gold-rated campus is equipped with seamless systems to reduce, reuse and recycle resources. With the increased capacity to harvest rainwater by 50%, drip irrigation, solar panels on the rooftop with a capacity of 238 kWp and shared transport, the campus creates an energy-efficient and sustainable space.

The Equinox journey is focused on enhancing occupier comfort and well-being. With the application of a central cooling system along with MERV 13 filters for enhanced air quality, destination-controlled elevators, digitized access and seamless circulation and connectivity, the campus fosters the well-being and operational efficiency of tenants. The lobbies of all the towers here are upgraded with premium finishes, enhanced circulation and lighting. The campus has been digitized with RFID-based controlled access as well as integrated BMS for efficient operations.

The transformation of Equinox is focused on the overall visual and physical connection of internal and external environments, as one space flows into the other. It is a work destination with a heart, offering a sense of belonging and premium experience. With this transformation of Equinox, we continue to provide solutions relevant today and for decades to come.







Ecoworld In Bengaluru Achieves True Gold Certification For Solid Waste Management

The grade 'A' campus, spread across 45 acres of land, ensures efficient recycling of the waste with less than 5% of it going to landfills, making it the first commercial office development to attain this milestone in India and South-East Asia.

Recently added to the portfolio, Ecoworld, the largest office park by Brookfield Properties in India, has become the first commercial office development in India and South-East Asia to achieve True Gold Certification for Solid Waste Management.

Raising the bar of IT Parks in Bengaluru, Ecoworld is an office campus development designed for a natural and optimal energy footprint with extensive sustainable

features, making the campus energy efficient in a bustling metropolis city. As one of the largest office parks, the lush green campus is spread across 45 acres of land, consisting of 14 buildings offering 7.5M SF of leasable area. It houses close to 40,000 employees.

The grade 'A' campus has been a strong advocate for 'LEED' and diverts less than 5% of waste to landfills, recycling over 95% of waste to create reusable products such as T-shirts, bags, caps, pen stands, coasters, diaries and notebooks for its employees and tenants. It also houses rain gardens with natural water retention systems to reduce



pollutants and storm water runoff rate to the drains while increasing soil and groundwater infiltration. The campus treats 100% of wastewater through a renewed sewage treatment plant which is later used for irrigation. In addition, the campus is equipped with in-house composting and waste converters for producing organic manure using wet waste for landscaping and terrace gardening. A portion of this wet waste is also used for biogas generation as an alternative green fuel, thereby reaffirming our clear commitment to reducing the carbon footprint in the building.



Ecoworld's high performance in waste management under the LEED green building program is a testimony of the initiatives, operational efficiency and optimal utilization of natural resources to reduce our carbon footprint. The campus successfully recycles over 1,200 tonnes of waste generated in a calendar year through the remarkable IoT-based Waste Management system which goes on to show our commitment

towards sustainability that is firmly embedded in our strategic framework.

Environmental, social and governance excellence is core to how we conduct our business across the globe. In sync with this vision, Ecoworld fosters sustainable and eco-friendly practices among employees and occupants. We conduct workshops, awareness programs, training, healthy discussions, competitions, and camps regarding waste management to keep the safety of our tenants and employees at the forefront of our operations while providing everyone with a safe and clean environment throughout the year.







Brookfield Properties Becomes The First Commercial Real Estate Company In India To Receive Bureau Veritas' Safeguard Label

The label recognizes our commitment to providing and successfully delivering a safe and healthy work environment to our employees and tenants.

We have become the first commercial real estate company in the country to receive a prestigious 'Safeguard' label from Bureau Veritas for our commitment to ensure a high-quality work environment—in terms of health, safety and hygiene for employees and occupants at our campuses in Gurugram, Noida, Mumbai and Kolkata. The initiatives that we have been undertaking at our campuses include physical distancing, protective suits for the



cleaning crew, periodic fumigation, contactless hand sanitizers, maintaining good indoor air quality, regular temperature checks at entryways, restricting elevator usage to four persons at a time, routine health checkups and staff training, app-based visitor management solutions, a dedicated helpline number in case of emergencies and cleaning and sanitizing common areas which include reception, staircases, elevators, lobbies, etc.

In addition to the safety week, we also celebrated National Fire Service Week to create awareness on the importance of workplace safety








For many white-collar professionals, their days at work are defined by a relentless barrage of incoming emails and back-and-forth digital conversations. As a result, their actual productive output gets squeezed into the early morning or evenings and weekends, while their workdays transform into losing battles against their inboxes. *A World Without Email* by Cal Newport is a book that attempts to tackle this crisis.

In this book, Cal Newport (who is an associate professor of computer science at Georgetown University, USA) makes the case for a workplace in which, instead of haphazard messaging, clear processes define how tasks are identified, assigned and reviewed. Each employee works on a lesser number of things (but performs them better), important communication is streamlined and chat channels and inboxes are no longer central to how work unfolds.

The book will convince both employers and employees that the time has come for big changes, and will walk them through how to make them happen. ■




Take A Pause And #BreathePositivity
